The project, which a duration of 2 years and co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme, aims to promote the exchange of good practices among the participating organizations in relation to entrepreneurship education among young people.

In the framework of entrepreneurship education, we can talk about the 8 key competences defined by the European Union and that are the knowledge, skills and attitudes that people need for personal development, active citizenship and employability. Among them, adaptability, flexibility, capacity for initiative, ability to work in a team, creative thinking and the ability to solve problems are part of an "entrepreneurial spirit", playing a fundamental role in the employability of young people.

Therefore, we intend to offer young people the opportunity to promote and enhance the basic skills, personal, social, organizational and linguistic competences that influence the motivation to learn and to become actively involved in civil society.



Among the actions that will be carried out:

- Launch of a survey aimed to companies of different sectors for the evaluation of key competences most valued in job seekers,
- Training in Portugal aimed at youth workers, who will later become the trainers in each of the countries participating in a pilot training for ten young people.
- Entrepreneurship pilot training aimed at young people in each of the participating countries.
